## Library Delivery to the Homebound

The Clinton Public Library's Homebound Delivery program brings library materials to homebound residents of Clinton each month.



Trained volunteers visit residents to deliver and pick up items. Books and other materials are selected by library staff members, according to the preferences of the patrons.

To be eligible for this service, you must be a Clinton resident and unable to come to the library due to a permanent condition; or, a temporary condition that will last four weeks or more.

To apply for Homebound Delivery Service, fill out the application that is included in this brochure, and mail to Clinton Public Library (mailing address is on the application). You may also call at 242-8441.

Once you have returned the completed application, a library staff member will contact you to establish a delivery schedule and determine how many items you would like to receive at a time.

Staff members will choose items for you, based on your preferences. You may also suggest specific titles, subject to availability. You will be matched with one of our Homebound Delivery volunteers. These are dedicated community members who donate valuable time enabling us to provide this service.
