### A Different Way to Read

Before turning the page, ask your child what he thinks will happen next. You can also ask your child what other way the book could have ended.



### Fun with Letters

Write your child's name and have him copy it himself with alphabet stamps, stickers, or magnets.



### Just the Facts

At the library or bookstore, find books on your child's favorite topics. Cars, dinosaurs, dogs, and other topics are covered in on-level books with plenty of pictures, designed especially for kids this age.



### Take Letters Outside

The next time you are out in the park, or at the beach, or in the snow, use your surroundings to play with letters. Take turns writing letters in the snow, dirt, or sand.



### What Word Starts with...

Play a guessing game about your child's favorite words. What letter does "p-p-p-pirate" start with? Once your child guesses one correctly, see how many words you can come up with together that start with the same letter.



### Your Child the Author

Take advantage of your child's interest in talking by writing a book together. Start out with something simple, like describing a fun day at a park or visiting friends. Staple a few pieces of paper together, and write out one or two of your child's sentences on each page. Then, read the story to her and let her illustrate it.



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
